



## IMPORTANT TEST DAY INFORMATION

### **Water bottles:**

If you bring a water bottle into the exam, it must be a clear bottle with no words, with clear liquid. Remove any labels.

### **Watches:**

You must remove your watch—you cannot wear any kind of a watch in the test room. There is a large clock in the front of the room.

### **Bathroom:**

Please use the bathroom before checking in, as you will NOT be allowed to use the bathroom again until around 10am (the first available bathroom break is during the Reading component, which is the second part of the exam).

### **Clothing:**

Please understand that IELTS policy does not allow winter coats to be worn during the exam. Likewise, if your jacket or sweatshirt has a hood, it must remain down during the exam.

### **Hats and other headwear:**

You must remove hats, stocking caps, and other non-religious headwear before entering the exam room.

### **Additional belongings:**

Please do NOT bring extra personal items or belongings to the exam that are not absolutely necessary, as we will collect everything from you, except your passport.

### **Passports:**

Bring only the passport (or ID) that you used for registration. Remove ALL loose papers from inside the passport—these are NOT allowed inside the test room.

### **Follow instructions:**

Follow all instructions you receive from IELTS test day staff. If you do not follow instructions, you may receive a verbal warning, a written cancellation warning, or may be asked to leave the test, depending on the circumstances.

Note: If you are asked to sign a “Cancellation Warning,” this does NOT mean that your test has been cancelled and it will not affect your score—this is only a warning that your test may be cancelled IF you continue to not follow the IELTS policies and instructions.
